



RESULTS FROM A NATIONALLY REPRESENTATIVE SURVEY OF YOUNG PEOPLE AGE 18-30 TAKEN JULY 9-20...

✓ Most young people, across all races and ethnicities, favor rights and protections for LGBT people

- Majorities of young people of all races and ethnicities support allowing gays and lesbians to adopt children, equal employment rights for LGBT individuals, more efforts aimed at prevention/treatment of HIV/AIDS, sensitivity training of police around issues of transgender individuals, and government support for organizations that provide services to LGBT youth

Among young adults, there is broad support for policies aimed at protecting LGBT Americans

✓ Support for various LGBT rights and policies has increased since 2014, especially among young whites


- Among young whites, support has increased in the last two years for policies such as allowing gays and lesbians to legally adopt children (84 percent vs. 69 percent) and equal employment rights for LGBT individuals (92 percent vs. 84 percent)

✓ Support for health insurance coverage of transgender health issues depends on how the policy is described

- Young African Americans, Asian Americans, and Latino/as are more supportive of coverage of transgender health issues when asked about the policy in general/abstract terms than when specific examples are included
- Support for coverage of transgender health issues is lower when young people are provided examples of transgender health issues "such as hormone treatments and sexual reassignment surgery"
